- Ability to develop and maintain record keeping systems and procedures.
- Ability to gather data, to compile information, and compile reports, strong financial management skills and systems.

The scope of services to be provided will include the following:

- To provide shelter services to victims of gender-based violence.
- Interventions with the children who enter the shelter with their mother's.
- Early Childhood Development Services,
- Educational support groups,
- Referral of services to the alleged perpetrator.
- Development of an exit strategy and reintegration plan for each client.
- Accredited skills development and training.
- Job placement as part of the exit strategy.
- Court preparation services.
- Applications for protection order.
- Networking with various government and non-government stakeholders in line with the National Strategic plan on GBV.
